

Facility Rental Terms and Conditions

We are pleased to have you as a renter of the museum's operated by the Manitowoc County Historical Society. The Heritage Center and Pinecrest Historical Village offer unique and exciting alternatives to a typical facility rental space for any special event or occasion.

Facility Rental Fees

The facility rental does not include the security deposit (see below) and is due in full either before or on the day of the contracted event.

Security Deposit

A security deposit is required with the signed contract. The security deposit may be applied to damages incurred to the Society by the rental or the renter's guests or vendors. The security deposit is applicable at the discretion of the Society and is \$50.00.

Facility Rooms and Details

With the base rental fee includes set-up/break-down, tables and chairs. Rates are per hour. Rental can add one half-hour at the beginning for set-up and one half-hour at the end for breakdown at no extra charge. Non-profit and community groups should contact the Society for special pricing and accommodations.

Mirro Auditorium – Heritage Center 72 for seated at round tables (6-8 at each table) 120 for lecture style seating

Nennig Dance Pavilion – Pinecrest Historical Village 80 for seated at long wooden tables (8 at each table) 100 for lecture style seating

Two Creeks Town Hall – Pinecrest Historical Village 80 for seated at long wooden tables (8 at each table) Can be used for various purposes with lecture style seating

Furniture and Equipment

The renter must provide their own linens, serving ware, coffee urns and other serving dishes that are needed.

Decorations and Clean-up

- The renter and/or caterer is responsible for cleaning the rented area after the event.
- Areas left unclean or any damage to property may result in forfeiture of the entire security deposit.
- Any rental equipment, including tables, chairs, linens and/or decorations must be delivered and removed the day of the event unless otherwise authorized.

Use of Facilities/Prohibited Activities

The presences of illegal substances, firearms or other weapons on the Society premises are strictly prohibited. The renter, and renter's guests, shall not exhibit or allow nudity, or lewd, lascivious or other behavior that reflects negatively on the Society. The Society reserves the right to cancel any event in which such behavior is exhibited or anticipated and the renter shall forfeit all fees previously paid to the Society.

The Society is not responsible for articles left in unattended vehicles. Parking is free and available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
