Ben Clark will present “The Fromms and Their Fur Farm” on Sunday, October 8 at the Merrill History and Culture Center, 100 E. Third Street. Clark, a Marathon County Historical Society Archivist, will outline the history of the remarkable Fromm family and their lasting impact on the world of fur farming and fashion.

The program will trace the rise and fall of the Fromm Brothers’ empire, built on their trademark bright silver fox fur. From the origins of their farm in Hamburg through their successes and failures; learn how the Fromms influenced the fur and fashion industries of the early 20th century and became one of the iconic success stories of Marathon County.
