BRING YOUR COLLECTIONS ONLINE

Does your organization need a solution for online access to your photographs, documents, oral histories or other historical resources? We partner with the Milwaukee Public Library to host digital collections using the CONTENTdm content management system. This service provides online public access to your unique collections through a customized landing page as well as discovery through Recollection Wisconsin and the Digital Public Library of America (DPLA).

Cost: One-time setup fee of \$200; annual hosting fee starts at \$75 for up to 500 items. (Thanks to the Wisconsin Public Library Consortium, annual fees are waived for public libraries in Wisconsin.)

Does your library, museum or historical society already manage an online collection of cultural heritage resources? We partner with UW-Madison to harvest metadata from digital collections for discovery through Recollection Wisconsin and the Digital Public Library of America (DPLA). We can currently harvest metadata from collections in CONTENTdm, ResCarta and Omeka.

Cost: One-time setup fee of \$100; annual harvesting fee starts at \$50 for up to 5 collections.
