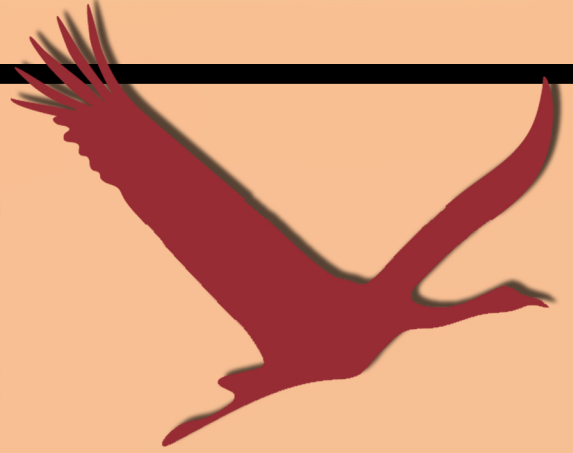

NECEDAH 100, a weekend of events inspired by this 1919 homecoming and taking place 100 years later, shares those goals.

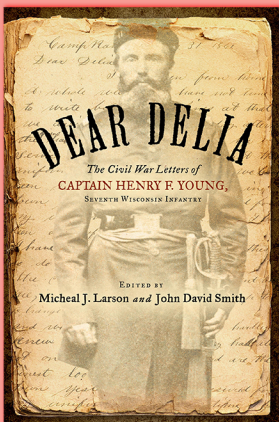
